**TIME IN** evokes the complicated landscape of these incarcerated women—mothers, daughters, wives—many with battered histories of physical abuse, drugs, street life—“good women making bad choices.” WOTC’s unique and spirited harmonies counterpoint the movement and text as the audience is led through a journey beginning with the prison’s origins as a Native American hunting ground to a farm, to the massive concrete structure that exists today. *TIME IN* challenges our assumptions about incarceration in a piece that provokes, evokes, and surprises through JDPE’s characteristically innovative performance mix.

**TIME IN** will be presented by the Charter Oak Cultural Center on November 2nd, 3rd, and 4th, 2006 at 7:30PM.
